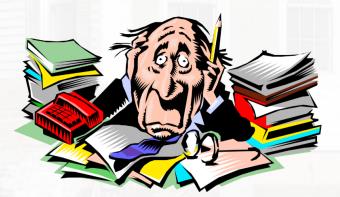

Tips for Searching

Keyword Search

The Keyword Search button allows you to perform a general search across multiple fields for any catalog records online. Keyword searches use OR as the default connector between words (e.g. a search for *Hanley Ranch* will return records associated with *Hanley OR Ranch*). If you want to find records where both keywords are found, type in AND between the two words. To search for a specific phrase, be sure to put the phrase within quotes (e.g. "Rocky Pine Ranch"). You can also use the asterisk (*) as a wildcard (e.g. a search for *histor** would come up with records containing *history, histories, historical,* etc.). Searches are not case sensitive.

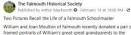

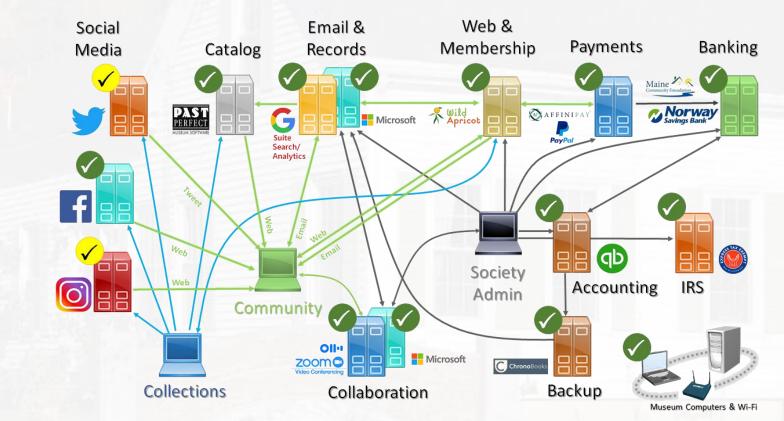

Last month we focused on a targeted program to solicit donations

Now we step back and examine the "big picture"





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New Business

We have made good progress in restoring the Society to full health

Financially, we're barely treading water

• Can't keep it up much longer





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New Business

Current income is not enough to keep the lights on

- Only 40% of expenses for reduced operations (Museum shut down for half the year)
- Only 20% of expenses for normal operations





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New Business

Must grow income five-fold

- Bounce back from Covid 1.
- Expand our traditional sources 2.
- Develop new sources 3.
- 4. The Last Resort





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New Business

Bouncing back from Covid

- 1. Ongoing campaign to restore membership to normal levels (and keep it there)
- 2. Re-open the Museum
- 3. FHS table at town events

Timeframe: this year





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New Business

Expand our traditional sources of income

- 1. New merchandise
 - Cookbook
 - Tote bag
- 2. Campaign to attract new members
- 3. Renew existing sponsors
 - Glossy to tell our story

Timeframe: this year into next





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New Business

Dependent upon building our "brand"

- 1. Sustained outreach
 - Printed newsletter (quarterly)
 - Online content via website & social media
- 2. Resumption of traditional programs

Timeframe: this year into next

Develop new sources of income

- 1. Targeted fundraising
- 2. Grants
