Our finances are in much better shape today than four years ago

- Then it was "controlled flight into terrain"
- Now it is "teetering between being in the black or the red"





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New Business

Key metrics give us early warning of trouble

- "Flashing red light" in this month's report
- "Unrestricted net current assets" is negative
- Tells us our available cash is now 25% less than at the beginning of the fiscal year
- We're spending beyond our means





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New Business

Where did the money go?

- Last year's sump problems put a \$1,267 dent in our operating accounts
- We are running \$775 over budget
 - Inflation has increased costs across the board
- We have \$1,643 tied up in new merchandise
 - -\$1,078 in manufacturing
 - **−**\$566 in inventory





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New Business

Not time to hit the panic button (yet)

Potential income to offset shortfall

- \$1,000 received from manufacturer of sump pump to offset direct costs
- Sale of merchandise this summer
- \$1,000 pledge
- \$1,270 normal distribution from foundation

2023-4 budget will reflect higher costs
